

Policy on student status and privileges

- Unsatisfactory record:

A student whose record does not meet the general requirements of the CEU or the requirements specific to the Department of Political Science will, upon the recommendation of the department, be informed by the Academic Pro-Rector about the termination of degree candidacy and student status at the end of the given term. In exceptional cases the department can extend the ordinary deadline for satisfying specific requirements if this is well justified by health-related or other serious reasons.. For the period of such a deferral the student may, upon the recommendation of the department, be placed on formal academic probation by the Administrative Board.

- Non-attendance:

The student status may be terminated by the department if a student fails to attend courses for more than 2 weeks without notifying the department about the reasons and obtaining permission for his or her absence.

Suspension of student status is followed by the cancellation of the contractual relationship between the student and the CEU.

The department informs the student about the initiation of this procedure via his/her CEU-provided email address and mailbox. Cancellation of student status is announced by mail sent to the home address indicated on the CEU application form.

The absence of the student from Budapest, unless approved by the Head of the Department in advance, is not a valid ground for complaint against the cancellation of student status or the initiation of the procedure that may lead to this step.
